ABOUT SAFE BUS:

Bus transport is an essential part of the EU public space and infrastructure and needs to remain safe and secure from the perspective of its users, its operators, and every member of the EU society. Due to their open nature and public character, public bus transport systems are considered a high-risk target that are vulnerable to various security risks, including terrorism.

The main objectives of SAFE BUS are to create new terrorism prevention capacities through a training programme, strengthen cooperation between security services and public transport providers, and identify best practices about the public transport system. Furthermore, it will boost the uptake of knowledge about transport safety and emergency services across Europe and implement best practices in a wide range of EU countries.

PROJECT OUTCOMES:



Implementation of ready-to-use e-learning courses and creation of handbooks for bus managers and drivers.



Establishment of a repository of solutions and best practice and awareness raising activities to enhance protection of public spaces.



Enhancing public-private cooperation through joint exercises, training programmes, tools for communication, exchanges of information and best practices.
